Questions for personal reflection and group discussion based on this week's teaching.

- 1. Have you experienced any "burning bush" experiences in your life? In terms of what God was asking of you did you question them? Avoid them? Follow them?
- 2. A voice from a burning bush is pretty obvious, but how do you discern what God may ask of you in more subtle ways? Most of the time God asks us to live our lives as witnesses to him in the everyday things of life. How do you distinguish between simply seeking to live a godly life, and following the specific things God may ask of you?
- 3. Q is not how can you be more like Moses, but how can you be you? What is God asking of you at this time?
- 4. Whatever God asks of you, he says "I will be with you." What does that mean in reality? How can you experience that?
